City Drug Now Compounds Semaglutide

You may have heard of Mounjaro, Ozempic, Rybelsus, Trulicity, Victoza, or Bydureon. These drugs are a class of drugs (called glucagon-like peptide 1 or GLP-1 agonists), which slow the movement of food from the stomach into the small intestine, and as a result, you feel full faster and longer, so you eat less. These drugs have also become popular because they increase insulin sensitivity to type 2 diabetics as well as reduce weight. Studies have shown those using semaglutide and making lifestyle changes lost roughly 33.7 lbs vs 5.7 lbs in those who didn't use the drug. It also lowers the risk of heart failure, stroke and kidney disease.

City Drug is now providing semaglutide to its patients who have a prescription. It comes in a vial with a dropper that you use to drop the semaglutide underneath your tongue. It is then absorbed directly into the bloodstream. You can speak to your medical provider about side effects and other instructions.

The price of the above drugs is quite high - some over \$1,000 / mo. Our compounded semaglutide starts at \$175.00 cash for a 30-day supply, making it affordable for more people. The price does increase when your dosage increases.
